

CIT Ambassador, Counselor in Training and Senior Counselor Responsibilities

CIT Ambassador

Who can be an Ambassador?

Ambassadors are youth ages 13 to 15 years and receive 50% off camp tuition.

Training date: June 23rd from 10am – 3:00pm

Training will include:

- Blog training and learning to use video, tutorials, and photographs to tell their stories
- Learning to lead games and icebreakers for campers during morning circle
- Safety and conflict management

What will I do?

- Documenting daily events and programs at camp by making videos, tutorials and blog posts. Senior counselors will be responsible for assisting the ambassadors execute the blog posts.
- Leading games and activities for the campers during morning circle and free time with the assistance of senior counselors, under the supervision of the assistant camp director.
- Assisting with weekly parent program. They will be in charge of the refreshment table and any other activities planned for the event. This includes setting up, breaking down, cleaning tables, bowls, etc.

Counselor in Training

Who can be a CIT?

CIT are youth ages 13 to 15 years of age and receive 50% off camp tuition.

Training Date: June 21st from 10am – 3pm

Training will include:

- Safety training and conflict management
- Creating workshops and games for the campers
- Organizing the classroom and prepping materials

What will I do?

- Overseeing a small group of assigned campers each week. Helping campers during workshops to complete and stay on task, walk them to the bathroom, make sure they have all belongings at the end of the day.
- Helping camp staff set-up for activities including: organizing tables and chairs, covering tables, moving supplies, organizing completed art work, cleaning classroom daily
- Leading a weekly workshop with the assistance of senior counselors.
- Assisting with the weekly tour and art show for the parent event. This includes making sure each camper has at least one piece of artwork displayed and are prepared to give a parent tour.

Senior Counselor

Who can be a senior counselor?

Senior Counselors are youth ages 16 and up with at least two years of experience in a camp setting.

Training Dates: June 21st & 23rd from 10am to 3:00pm

Training will include:

- Safety and Conflict Management
- Creating workshops and games for campers
- Organizing the classroom and prepping materials

What will I do?

- Counselors are responsible, with the CITS, for a small group of assigned campers each week. They will help those campers during workshops to complete and stay on task, walk them to the bathroom, make sure they have all belongings at the end of the day.
- Leading five workshops (one per week) for the campers based on the theme
- Assisting with origami lessons and language games
- Overseeing the CITS to make sure that they are on task and assisting the campers
- Responsible for hanging the weekly art show and assigning tour spots for campers.
